38th Annual High School Student Art Competition

ELIGIBILITY

Students grades 9-12 from schools within a fifty mile radius of Quincy, Illinois are eligible. Works will be judged for inclusion in the exhibit, and those accepted for display must meet the following criteria:

Entries need to be received at the Art Center by Thursday, March 17, 2012 at 4:00 p.m.

Conditions:

Students may enter up to 3 works for \$5.

All artwork must be original. No copies of copyrighted imagery are allowed. It is imperative that all two dimensional artwork be suitably framed, and ready for exhibition with a secure wire fastened to the back. String, sawtooth or plate hangers will not be accepted. White matting is preferred. Three dimensional and two dimensional artwork cannot be over 6 feet or 50 pounds.

Awards:

There will be \$1,000 in awards given this year. The awards will be in cash and gift certificates distributed as Best of Show, 2nd Place, 3rd Place, Merit Awards, Honorable Mention Awards and several sponsored awards. All awards will be presented at the discretion of the judge. Criteria for awards include originality and quality of artwork. Reception and Awards Presentation will be on Friday, April , 2012, 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.; Awards Presentation is at 5:00 p.m. Award winners will also be invited to co-curate the following summer's Permanent Collection Exhibition at the Quincy Art Center.
