

Food for Thought

Did you know? The Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci is painted on a wall! Being da Vinci's first time working in the medium of fresco he did not mix the paint pigment into the wet plaster, he instead placed the pigment onto dry plaster leading to great deterioration over time, very little of the orginal is left.

Daniel Chester French, sculpture of Abraham Lincoln among other famous statues, was encouraged to become and artist by Louisa May Alcott, author of Little Women. Who encourages you to do the things that you love?

Did you know? You can use fruits, vegetables, spices, and more to create natural dyes for easter eggs.
