



The Quincy Art Center (otherwise referred to as The Art Center) has put in place, to assist in protecting the health and safety of you (patron), other patrons, and our staff, a series of condition patrons must agree upon and comply with for use of The Art Center facility. Please read this form then print and sign your name and date for our records.

- Patrons must enter The Art Center facility through the 16th Street entrance (east entrance), and exit the same way.
- Patrons will not bring additional guests into the facility, unless it is an adult accompanying a minor. This includes private parties.
- Patrons will not visit The Art Center if they have tested positive for COVID-19 and are not cleared by their physician to exit quarantine.
- Patrons will not visit The Art Center if they have been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or are personally showing symptoms such as: experienced fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, and/or exhibited any other flu-like symptoms or respiratory issues in the last fourteen (14) days.
- Patrons must wear a face mask upon entry to the facility and wear a face mask throughout their entire time within the facility.
- Patrons will be required to have their temperature taken upon entry into the facility.
 - If an individual has a temperature of 100.4F or higher they will not be allowed to enter the facility and are advised to go home immediately and contact their health care provider, as recommended by the CDC (Center for Disease Control).
- Patron agrees if they begin to feel sick or start developing COVID-19 symptoms, they will notify the instructor or staff member of their symptoms, what equipment they were using, and leave the building immediately.
- Patron will sanitize their hands before entering the building. Hand-sanitizing stations will be positioned at the main entrance to The Art Center.
- Patrons are not allowed to bring equipment/bags from outside – with the exception of their own filled water bottle.
 - Water fountains and vending machines are “out of order”.
- Patrons will comply with all social distancing and capacity protocol while in the facility.
- Patrons will adhere to the CDC guidelines of covering their coughs and sneezes, and should wash and sanitize their hands frequently.
- Patrons are to wipe down the equipment and tools with the provided sanitizing wipes before and after use.
- Patrons are not allowed to share equipment, and can only use one piece of equipment at a time.
- Patrons must stay out of closed areas and off of equipment designated as unavailable.
- Patrons must adhere to all Art Center COVID-19 precautions and policies while on property.



- Drop-off & Pick-up of Minors:
 - The Instructor will meet all students at the door to conduct health screenings with accompanying adult present. If another adult is picking up the student, please inform instructor at this time.
 - All students will practice social distancing in the lobby until everyone is present before entering down into the studio.
 - Please arrive 5 - 10 minutes before class to ensure class can begin on-time.
 - The Instructor will bring all students back to the lobby at the end of class for pick-up.
 - Adults in charge of picking up students are asked to line their cars along the 16th Street curved drive and to stay in their cars. Students will be let out one-by-one in order of their drivers. Drivers will need to identify themselves before students are allowed to enter car.

LIABILITY WAIVER - I understand that use of the facilities at the Quincy Art Center may involve risk of exposure to contagion (including COVID-19), and I agree to assume any such risks. I understand that it is up to me to consult physicians and other professionals to make sure that I can safely participate in classes and workshops at the Quincy Art Center. I also understand and agree that by signing this agreement, I am giving up my (or the minor for whom I sign) right to make any claim against the Quincy Art Center, its board, employees, and volunteers, including the right to sue them, for bodily injury, illness, or any other loss that I might suffer while using the Quincy Art Center facilities and services, except as limited by law.
