



4th Annual High School Art Teacher Exhibit

Exhibit Dates: January 23 - February 25, 2021

Eligibility High School Visual Art Teachers that have students entering the 47th Annual High School Student Art Competition and teach in one of the eligible counties listed on the competition prospectus are eligible. All works entered will be displayed.

Entries High School Visual Art Teachers may enter one artwork at no cost. All mediums are eligible. All artwork must be original. All two-dimensional artwork should be matted or framed, and ready for exhibition with a secure wire fastened to the back. Sawtooth or plate hangers are not preferred. Pedestals are provided. Artwork requiring a digital presentation must come with its own viewing device. Artwork cannot be over 6 feet in any one direction. Artwork must not have been previously exhibited at the Art Center or its satellite exhibit spaces.

Awards All awards will be presented at the discretion of the juror. Criteria for awards include originality and quality of artwork. One art teacher will be awarded \$300 to use towards their classroom to purchase art supplies, art equipment, or an art lesson brought to your classroom by the Art Center.

Juror A professional from outside the eligible region with expertise in the visual arts is selected to choose the work for exhibition and awards. The staff and board of the Art Center are never involved in the selection process.

Publicity The Quincy Art Center shall have the right to photograph any work for educational and publicity purposes.

Insurance The utmost care will be taken in the handling of works, the Quincy Art Center assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any artwork.

Sales Artists are able to price and sell their artwork. The Quincy Art Center will retain a 30% commission of the sales price in support of the programs of the Art Center.
