Teen Take Over and Awards Ceremony: Saturday, Jan. 28, 1–3pm, with awards at 2:30pm

**Eligibility:** High School Visual Art Teachers that have students entering the 49<sup>th</sup> Annual High School Student Art Competition and teach in one of the eligible counties are eligible.

**Entrance Requirements:** Art Teachers may enter one artwork at no cost. All mediums are eligible. Artwork must be original. Artwork cannot be over 6 feet in any one direction.

**Presentation and Content:** Works must be ready for exhibition. All wall-hung work must be equipped with hanging devices, such as a secure wire fastened to the frame. Sawtooth or plate hangers are not preferred. No damaged mats. Pedestals are provided for 3D work. Artwork requiring a digital presentation must come with its own viewing device. The Art Center reserves the right to install works in any manner deemed necessary for exhibition or security reasons. Due to the wide variety of visitors, all entries must be appropriate for viewing by all ages. The Art Center reserves the right to refuse any work that may be considered potentially offensive.

QAC staff and board are not involved in the selection. **Award:** One art teacher will be awarded \$300 to use towards their art classroom.

**Sales:** Sales to the public will be encouraged. The Art Center will retain a 30% commission.
